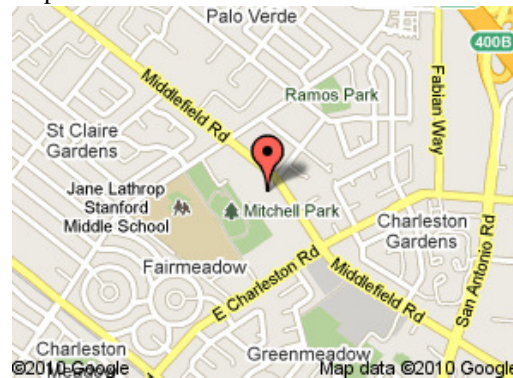
She is the symbol of peace & democracy and beacon of hope for people all over the world who are suffering under oppression and injustice.
